Entering & Departing Australia

Operators intending to bring a superyacht to Australia (under its own power) must notify Customs and Border Protection of the impending arrival no later than 96 hours before arrival into first Australian Port. Impending arrival reports may be made by email to yachtreport@customs.gov.au and the documentary requirements may be found at www.customs.gov.au/site/page4358.asp or via a port agent. Failure to advise Customs of arrival as required above will incur penalties.

Clearance Information

Superyachts that arrive into Australia to stay for a period of time are said to have broken their international voyage status and therefore subject to one of the following options being applied:

- If the yacht Ownership is Australian then the vessel will need to be entered for home consumption – (duty and Goods and Services Tax (GST) paid or deferred, if applicable)
- Enter the superyacht for warehousing (no duty or GST is paid) – currently there are no marina style warehouses in Australia
- If the vessel is planning to stay for an extended period or planning to undergo a refit then a temporary importation entry for a maximum stay of 12 months will be requested - a security or undertaking may be required (or in limited cases an ATA Carnet)
- If privately cruising the vessel will obtain a control permit* for up to 12 months – no security required

** Control permits are only available for pleasure craft that arrive under their own power for specified purposes i.e. private cruising*

Immigration

All non-Australian and non-New Zealander crew arriving into Australia either on board or to embark a superyacht is required to obtain a Subclass 488 Superyacht Crew Visa prior to arrival into Australia. This visa class will permit crew to work in their usual role on board the vessel whilst the vessel is in Australia. Superyacht crew (subclass 488) visas are valid for up to 12 months from the date of issue. Conditions apply and crew issued with a 488 superyacht crew visa must note their individual conditions. These conditions can be:

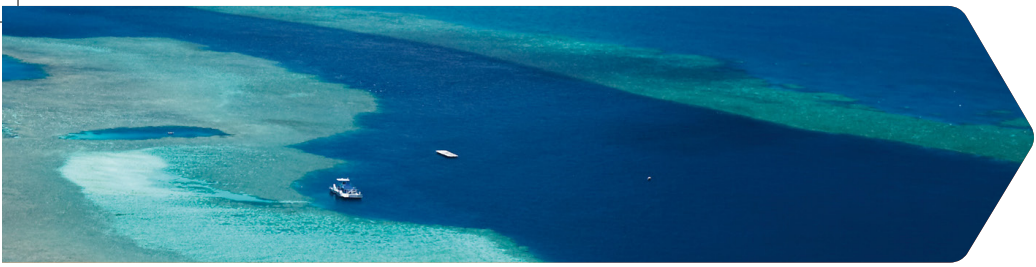
- Visa only permits a three, six or twelve month stay from each time of arrival
- Crew will be permitted to enter Australia on multiple occasions during the 12 month validity of the visa
- Only permitted to work on board the yacht named in their initial visa application, they are not permitted to work in Australia once they have officially disembarked the vessel for vacation or ceased employment with that particular vessels owner or visa sponsor.

Quarantine

DAFF Biosecurity has developed operator guidelines for vessels less than 25 metres and vessels greater than 25 metres arriving in Australia to assist masters, agents and owners to comply with quarantine requirements. It is the responsibility of the user to check that they have the latest version and to ensure compliance with legislation.

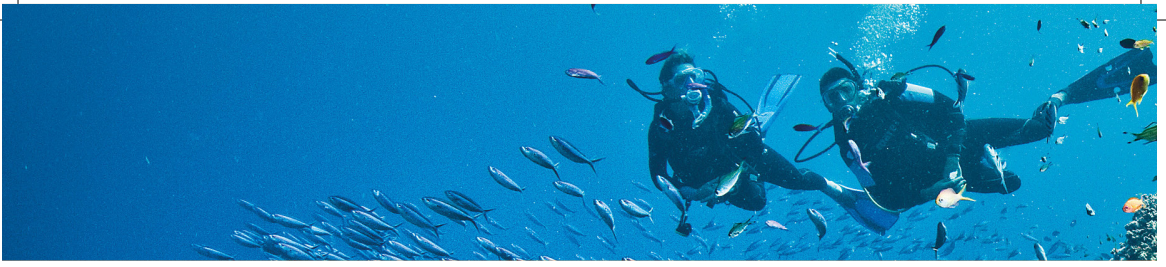

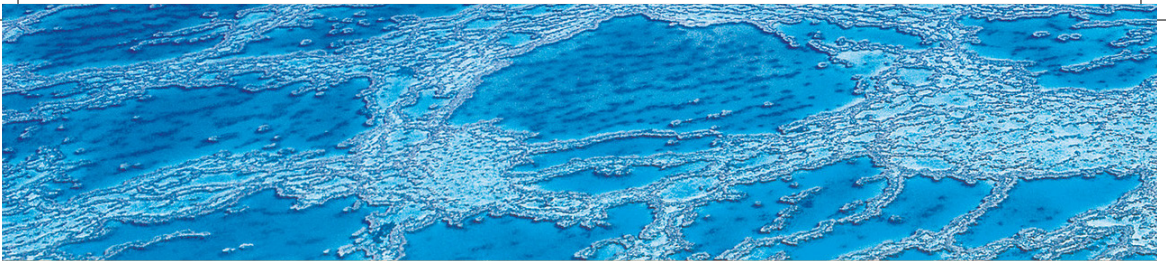

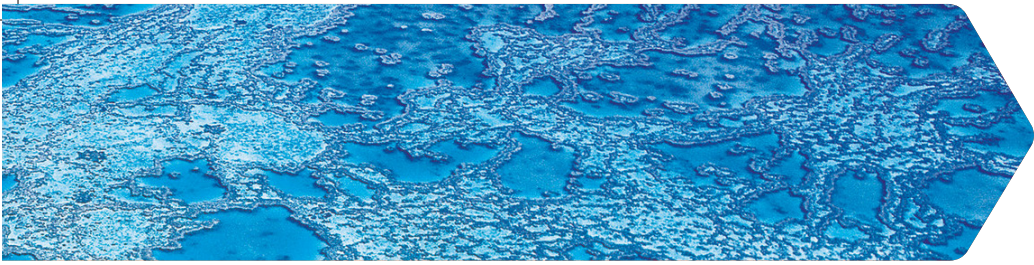
